- Energy Star rated equipment used when available



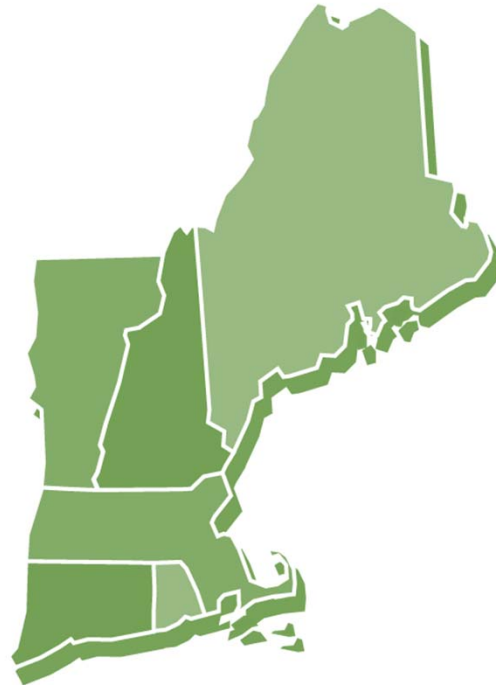
